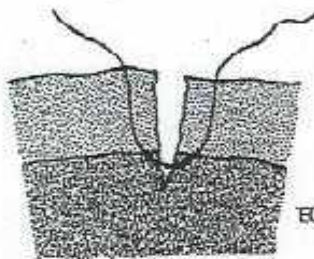


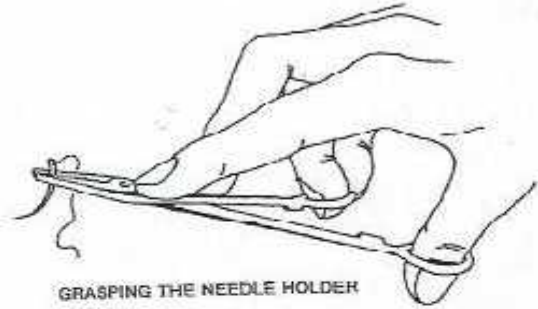
SUTURING GUIDE ILLUSTRATIONS

Suturing Guide

1. Disinfect area and flush wound before suturing
2. Anesthetize with 2% Xylocaine if available
3. Four stitches per inch with 3.0 Ethilon suture and FS-1 needle
4. Six stitches per inch with 5.0 Etholon and FS-1 needle for face

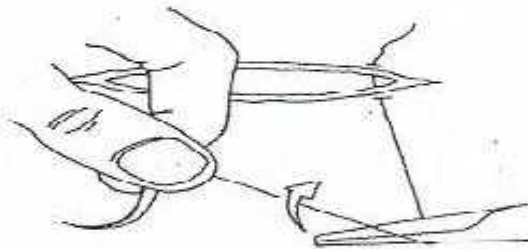


PROPER PLACEMENT

EQUAL DEPTH ON BOTH SIDES OF CUT.

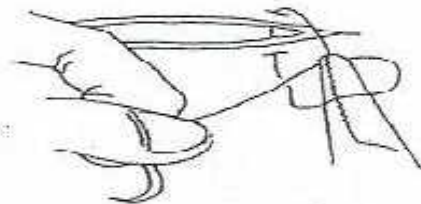


GRASPING THE NEEDLE HOLDER

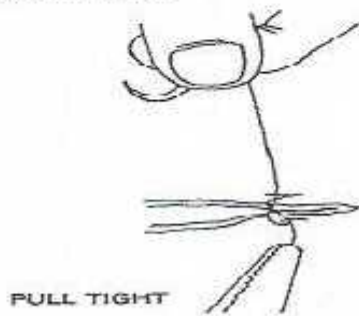
FORMING A SQUARE KNOT USING A NEEDLE HOLDER



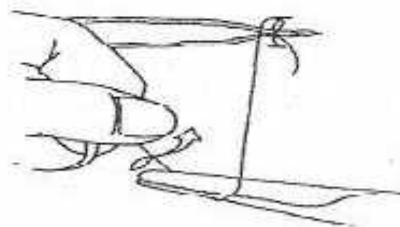
LOOP HOLDER



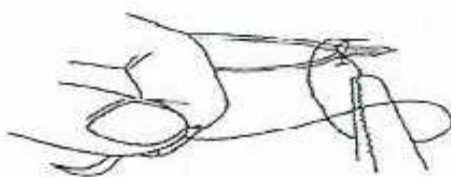
GRASP END THROUGH LOOP



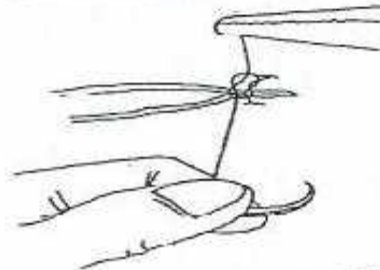
PULL TIGHT



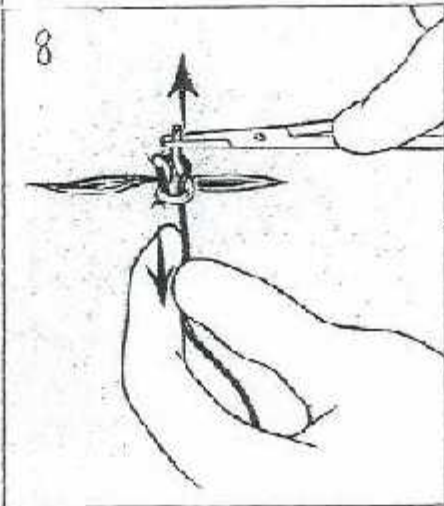
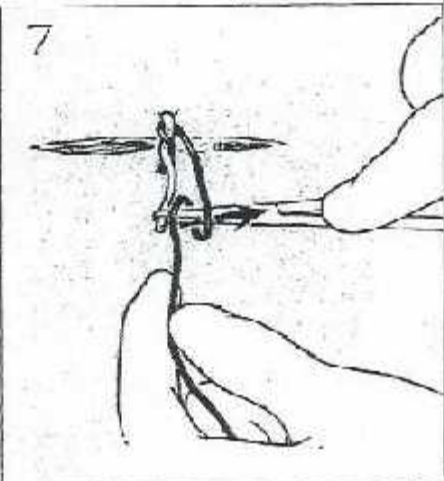
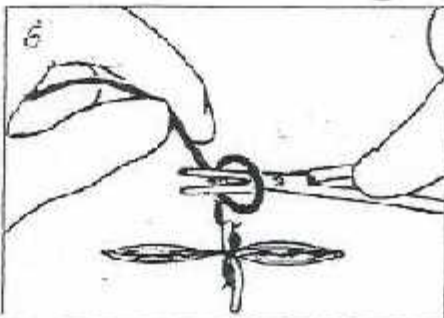
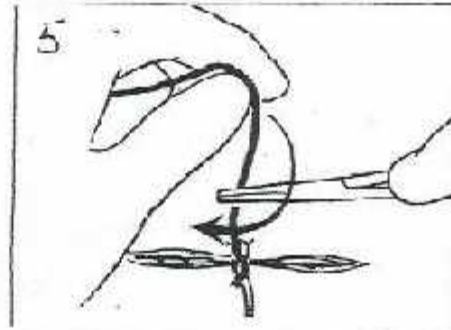
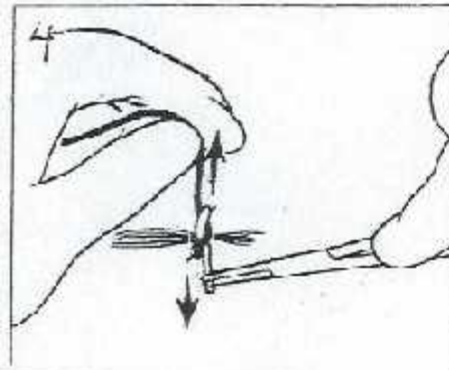
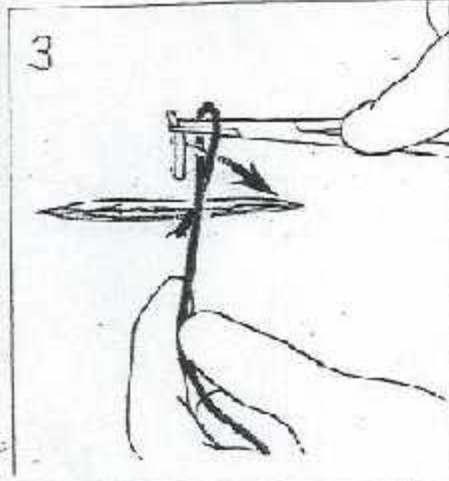
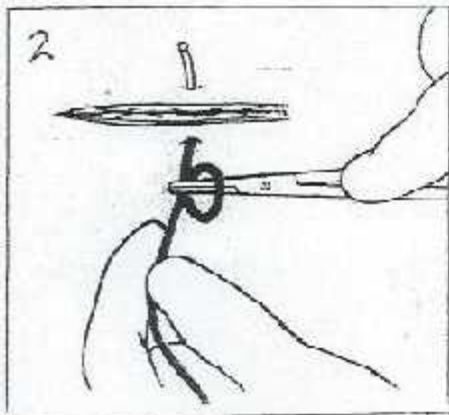
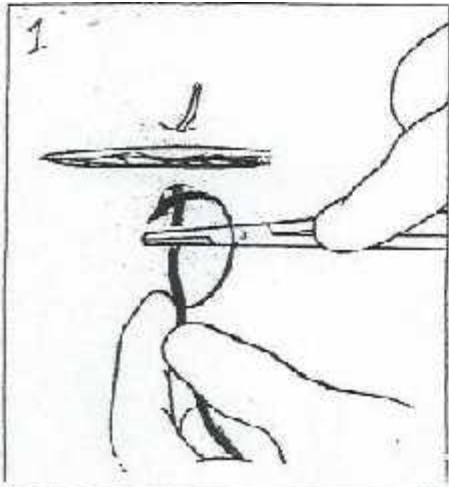
LOOP HOLDER IN REVERSE



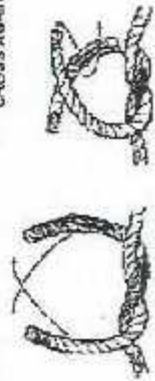
GRASP END THROUGH LOOP
